With an impressive volume of approximately 1,760 m³ and a private plot of 797 m², this villa unquestionably ranks among the finest residential properties currently available in The Hague.

Everything here revolves around light, space, sightlines and perfection.

Architecture as an Art Form

The villa's distinctive geometry subtly follows the contours of the plot, allowing every room to benefit from optimal natural daylight, privacy and beautiful views over the professionally landscaped garden. The harmonious combination of natural stone, glass, steel and premium finishes creates an international architectural style comparable to contemporary residences in cities such as London, Zurich and Copenhagen.

From the moment you enter the impressive entrance hall, the extraordinary scale of the home becomes immediately apparent. High ceilings, sleek cast flooring, minimalist detailing and uninterrupted sightlines create a spectacular first impression.

A Living Floor Designed for Exceptional Living

The heart of the villa is undoubtedly its spectacular living level.

At the front of the residence lies the magnificent 50 m² bespoke kitchen, designed by Bulthaup and equipped with top-of-the-line Gaggenau appliances. The generous kitchen island naturally serves as the centrepiece where cooking, dining and entertaining effortlessly come together. Floor-to-ceiling windows flood the space with beautiful morning sunlight.

At the rear, the impressive split-level living room of more than 63 m² unfolds. The varying floor levels create remarkable spatial dynamics while naturally defining several elegant living areas. A ceiling height of approximately 3.5 metres, a contemporary gas fireplace and a fully glazed rear façade create an exceptional setting for both intimate family evenings and sophisticated entertaining.

Large sliding glass doors seamlessly connect the interior with the spacious south-facing terrace, creating an effortless transition between indoor and outdoor living.

A Private Floor of Exceptional Luxury

The first floor continues the atmosphere of tranquillity and refined luxury.

Three generously proportioned bedrooms, together with a beautifully appointed designer bathroom, create the ideal family

accommodation.

On the quieter side of the home is an impressive 27 m² home office—an inspiring workspace filled with natural daylight, perfectly suited for professionals who work from home.

The undisputed highlight is the completely private master suite.

A luxurious wellness bathroom featuring a freestanding bathtub, spacious walk-in shower, double vanity and toilet leads into a bespoke walk-in dressing room. From there, you enter the elegant master bedroom overlooking the landscaped garden and equipped with air conditioning.

A hotel-quality private suite where comfort, tranquillity and luxury come together in perfect harmony.

A Lower Ground Floor Offering Endless Possibilities

Where many homes end, this villa continues with an entire additional living level.

The beautifully finished lower ground floor includes an integrated double garage, several storage rooms, technical facilities and an impressive 58 m² fitness room.

This versatile level also offers outstanding opportunities to create a private wellness area, wine cellar, home cinema, games room, artist's studio or luxurious guest accommodation.

The architecture flows seamlessly into the outdoor spaces.

The elegant U-shaped design embraces the generous south-facing terrace, creating a wonderfully private outdoor living environment.

The professionally landscaped garden forms a beautiful contrast to the villa's contemporary architecture. Mature planting ensures complete privacy, while multiple terraces allow you to enjoy both sunshine and shade throughout the day.

The outdoor jacuzzi completes this exceptional setting and offers the perfect place to unwind in complete tranquillity.
